

FF APPDATA

What it does:

AppData saves whatever you type in a variable in memory so that if you use that variable again in another document, it displays what you typed last time. You can edit the text and it saves that for the next time. The information can be saved for the person or it can be saved for a specific person's case.

FF APPDATA/00 – Free form text field - Save person

This function provides a free form text field. Response is saved in AppData. It is intended to be used if you want to save the user's response to the variable name so that if you use the same function with the same variable name in another form, the response will default to whatever was entered the last time (for the first person tied to the document).

FF APPDATA/01 – Free form text field - Save person/case

This function provides a free form text field. Response is saved in AppData. It is intended to be used if you want to save the user's response to the variable name so that if you use the same function with the same variable name in another form, the response will default to whatever was entered the last time (for the first person/case tied to the document).
